



ACCESSIBILITY



DIOCESAN MUSEUM OF LA SPEZIA

The museum is equipped with access devices for people with disabilities.

Within the structure there is an elevator that allows access to every room.

The elevator service must be requested at the information point at the entrance of the museum (First floor) and the museum's staff will accompany the visitors. The museum is also provided with toilets accessible for people with disabilities (Third floor) and they can be reached by lift.

DIOCESAN MUSEUM OF SARZANA

The museum is equipped with access devices for people with disabilities.

Within the structure there is a stairlift that allows the visit of every room of the museum.

The stairlift service must be requested at the information point or by calling the number

+39 0187 625174, and the museum's staff will accompany the visitors.

The exit for people with disabilities is on the upper floor, where you will find a wheelchair ramp.

The museum is also provided with toilets on the ground floor.

DIOCESAN MUSEUM OF BRUGNATO

The structure is not equipped with access devices for people with disabilities, so the visit is limited to the ground floor, entering the museum via the entrance located in Piazza Ildebrando.

The museum offers a free guided visit to the Cathedral.
